Bell Buckle Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in special session to discuss a water tap for Addy and David Cataldo on Higgins Road and the Urban Growth Boundary. Those present were Mayor Webb, Aldermen Anderson, Hunt and Reagor. Alderman Felices was absent.

There was discussion regarding the pressure issue on that line. Engineer Patterson had written a letter stating that adding a tap to the line is not going to put the Town at risk of not meeting their obligations on the main line. He did, however, want the Board to warn the homeowner that there will likely be periods of low pressure on the line primarily at peak usage times. There were questions about Mr. Patterson's letter and he was called regarding these issues. Mayor Webb, seconded by Alderman Anderson, made a motion to approve the water tap pending a letter from Engineer Patterson stating specifically that he did not feel that adding this tap would make the pressure fall below the State's requirements. Alderman Reagor voted no; all others voted Aye. Motion carried. This part of the meeting was adjourned.

The Board then met with Planning Commission Chairman Rodney Simmons and Water/Sewer Supervisor Ronnie Lokey to discuss and study the Urban Growth Boundary. There was discussion regarding possibly changing the size of Bell Buckle's UGB and to seek approval to become a regional Planning Commission.

Mayor Webb stated he would speak with County Mayor Eugene Ray about some issues. These included Regional Planning Status, no step systems in rural areas, and the concerns around Hwy 82 for Shelbyville's UGB. He will bring a review back to the Board.

Meeting adjourned.
