Criteria for Bell Buckle Citizen of the Year

1. Who can nominate? *Anyone and everyone can make a nomination*
2. Who is eligible?
 - a. Must be Bell Buckle resident or property owner.*
 - b. Time lived here? *No time limit.*
 - c. Individuals, service groups, charitable organizations as long as they benefit the town and currently live in town and are based in town.
 - d. Service performed with pay or without *Does not matter.* Service should predominantly be in Bell Buckle and beneficial to Bell Buckle.
 - e. Anyone person or group that has won in the past may be nominated again with no time limit.

*An exception to nominee being a resident or property owner may be considered if all other criteria is met.
